ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- ❖ *At Least 18 Years Old*
- ❖ *Resident of the City of New Brunswick*
- ❖ *Legal U.S. Citizen*
- ❖ *Must volunteer a minimum of 96 hours annually to maintain Auxiliary Police Certification*
- ❖ *Must satisfactorily complete a 14 week Auxiliary Police Academy held at the Middlesex County Training Center in Edison, New Jersey 08817. Classes are every Tuesday and Thursday, 7:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. and every Saturday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.*
- ❖ *High School Diploma or G.E.D.*
- ❖ *Complete & Satisfy Criminal Background Check*
- ❖ *Possess valid NJ Driver's License*

RESPONSIBILITIES OF AN AUXILIARY POLICE OFFICER

Assists the Department wherever and whenever needed. (*i.e.* weather emergencies, traffic details, parades, other special events)

Available to be deployed as walking patrols as an Extension of the Police Department
